Credit cards are designed to be a flexible form of borrowing. Paying the minimum amount every so often can help you manage your money more effectively, although we would not recommend that you make the minimum payments for a long period of time once your promotional offers have ended. The following example highlights the difference between only paying the minimum and paying a fixed amount.

For a purchase of £1,000 on your Lloyds TSB Airmiles Duo Premier Credit Card account...

Monthly Payment	If you pay the Minimum Payment each month	If you pay £50 each month
Without taking into account any introductory rates, how much interest will you be charged in the first year?	<b>£126</b>	<b>£105</b>
How much interest will you be charged in the second year?	<b>£113</b>	<b>£38</b>
How long would it take to clear the balance?	19 years	2 years

The above example assumes the following:

- The transaction takes place on 1 January and you make no further transactions.
- You always make the payment each month on the 15th.
- Your statement is produced on the 1st of each month.

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
